

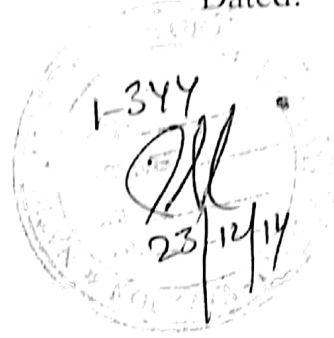

The meeting started with the briefing by Dr Anoop Nigwekar on the changing scenario of the Health Care sector. These were likely to impact the health care services.

1. The New Medical Education Policy which is promoting choice based education. Knowledge of Allied pathics will help integrate and facilitate health care services for the future.
2. Community based preventive medicines for the benefit of society will have focus.
3. The National Health Commission governs the health care education, research and ethics aspects. The area of interest for IMC RBNQA would be the plan for building a board of rating assessments. Assign third party organizations for assessing and rating organizations. This will get started effective from 2021.
4. NABH is typing up with IRDA. Benefits for rating in terms of Bronze, Silver and Gold. This will facilitate outreach to organizations for participation.
5. People Management and Technology adoption - Focus on capacity building, training and announcement. Skill upgradation is a necessity now with the emphasis on Robotics, AI and Telemedicine.

Telemedicine is now supported by government and doctors allowed to provide consultation through telemedicine. Therefore doctors need to enhance their skills.

6. Risk planning for emergencies especially non fire emergencies.

Mr H S Bhatt presented the following inputs:

1. Policy changes in the rural sector need to be also taken in to consideration.
2. Need to look at the various blind spots as patient care is vulnerable.
3. Governance has to have a tighter perspective.
4. Safety and Vigilance is to take prime importance in terms of patients and property.
5. The Work force hygiene needs to have a strong focus.
6. Lifestyle modification and ethical practices to be focused upon.
7. Movement of patients within campus need to be considered.
8. Sustainability in terms of brick and mortar and personal inputs need to be looked at.
9. Looking at collaborators which is also in the Core value of the IMC RBNQA Performance Excellence model
10. Ethics by medical professionals need to be focused upon.
11. The trinity is Patient - Doctor and Hospital. Important factors within the same are :
 - Doctor Shopping
 - Absence of family doctor
 - Google doctors
 - Fait in doctors
 - Health care lifestyle regiment
 - Cost of medicines
 - Medical accessories
 - Pharma & Drugs margin
 - Hospital acquired infections
 - Doctor Guidance
 - Substitution medicine
 - Monitoring of outsourced services

Dr.Alka Mitra focused on the importance of Leadership in every aspect of the functioning of an organization.

Decisions:

- It was concluded that Mr.Bhatt and Dr.Nigwekar will give inputs on the relevant changes to be considered in the IMC RBNQA health care criteria. This will be sent by Friday, 20 November 2020. We can then work out a suitable meeting date after going through the information.
- Umesh suggested that we try to get a copy of the New Education Policy and related documents in the health care sector.

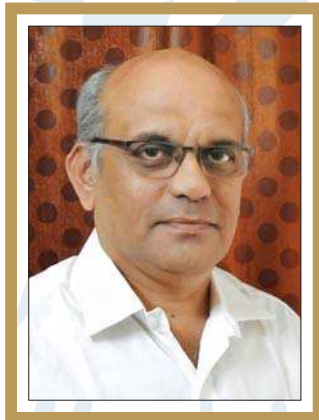
