Meeting started with brief introduction of attendees by Principal sir and congratulated parents being admitting their children in the institute of excellence. Parents were given chance to express their feelings and ask queries.

All the parents appreciated the initiative of MLDMHI to have a parent teacher meeting which provided them a platform to have one to one interaction with college authorities.

Most of the parents appreciated, well organised way of receiving their children in the campus and the most structured induction program being conducted over a period of four days.



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Suggestions given by parents – Institute should think of giving stipend from the day one to its students - Dr Bipin Jain sir has explained them the foundation of the Institute and Hospital is being based on charity and not profit making firm. He also ensured them that the institute has a provision to provide its students some stipend as a small token of appreciation of their work in MD part 2.

Parents were given chance to express their feelings and impressions about the institute which they received from their children's stay of four day. Many parents expressed that they are happy about the institute's stand to expose their children in village setup etc and exposing them both urban and village population.

Principal sir assured parents about the learning of students in next up coming 3 years. He explained them about student's would be daily routine in the campus for next 3 years and also appealed parents not to call students at home frequently. It would disturb their regular routine whereas he informed parents that students have the provision of leaves to meet their parents.

He insisted parents to support teachers in grooming their children while performing their clinical duties in the campus. He also explained them that the students might go into discomfort while performing on the campus which may develop some stress. But the Institute has provision of Mentoring system as strong support for students to strike the balance between undue emotions and duties.

He assured parents that their children would come up with flying colours at the end of three years. Few parents expressed their concern about their children's rest and night sleep while performing clinical duties. In response Principal sir explained them the daily routine of students and availability of



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adequate rest period in daily routine which seems to be convincing to the
parents.
