4.1.1. Teaching-Learning Facilities

a. Classrooms - There are total three classrooms available in the campus. One with capacity of 45 and two with capacity of 25 each. One classroom with 45 capacity is fitted with air condition, LCD projector, screen, one black board and one white board. Other two class rooms are having the facility of LCD projector, one black board.

b. Departments and learning materials

There are total Six departments for six subjects each comprised of

- 1. HOD room
- 2. Reader/lecturer room
- 3. Conference room

Each department is equipped with tables, chairs, computer, LCD projector, Departmental library Bookshelves – 2 White board Duster Markers

c. Conference room -

Auditorium with centralised air conditioner facility with capacity of 150 Comprised of 2 white boards and 2 LCD projectors with wifi connection.

d. Library -

There is availability of central library with space of 1800 sqft. Reading space is available for students. There are total 6113 books are available in the library with various subjects. There are total 15 periodicals (7 national and 8 international). Library subscribes for 11 journals. There are total 4 computers with internet facility are available. Five Homoeopathic software for repertorisation are available for the students. MUHS digital library has been made available for the students.

2. Administration

College has its own exclusive administrative area headed with Principal's cabin on the ground floor. It has separate reception area for receiving college visitors headed by clerk during college hours. All financial transactions are dealt in exclusive accounts section situated in the basement area.

3. Student facilities

a. Hostel – College has its own hostel accommodating male and female students in separate wings. Apart from students there is a provision for accommodating hospital staff and college faculty. Two separate wings for male and female students. 67 rooms. Each room is twin sharing. Each room is comprised of – 2 beds, 2 cupboards, 2 tables, 2 chairs, 2 tubelights, 1 fan. Attached toilet and bathroom for 2 rooms with solar hot water facility. Gas geysers on each floor. Drinking water cooler with UV and ultra-filtration settings.



b. Common rooms

Two separate common rooms are available for male and female students in the college and one common room is available in hostel where students can spend quality time with their inmates.

c. Canteen – Canteen facility is available in the college premises with dining area to cater 50 people at a time. Modern kitchen with electrical equipment and chimney. Separate grocery storage facility. One drinking water cooler with UV filtration facility
