AT MLDMHI, Pre-program Preparation/ Orientation:

Faculty: All supervisors and medical officers going to be involved in this program were orientated about the Malaysian culture, student sensitivities and Under-Graduate knowledge base

Post-graduate Students: a 2-day workshop for orientating and developing the teaching skills in PG students by Senior faculty members of MLDMHI was conducted, as it was done for last year senior batch students, as part of their curriculum need.

Orientation at MLDMHI:

Students were given orientation about the MLDMHI and how students will be learning maximum.

1. Over view of MLDMHI in Homoeopathic world was given glimpse and about legacy of Institute in teaching of Homoeopathy. Also about the competency of Faculty members in teaching Homoeopathy also highlighted.
2. Students were oriented with the major difficulty of Language barrier and how they can overcome same – with help of MD students was explained.
3. Classroom and bed-side sessions: how they will be conducted and method of circulating case material and case based learning. Submission of given assignments was emphasized.
4. Project work: about its course and assigning of Supervisors was given. Also involvement of Research Department in felicitating was conveyed.
5. Difficulty of Inter-personal level with MD students: students were made aware of the fact about the different attitude and temperament of MD students which vary among the group and were advised about approaching the Consultants and OPD Supervisors/ Medical officers primarily for their difficulties than MD students. They were asked to approach MD students whom they found to be co-operative in case of any help; otherwise emphasis was given more on approaching the Consultants and OPD Supervisors/ Medical officers primarily.
6. Issue of management of time in completing the entire academic (classroom/ bed-side sessions) + project + Clinical posting was highlighted. So that they become aware to manage time.
7. Clinical posting (OPD+IPD): was given overview and how it will help them with patient exposure and improving skills was highlighted.
