MID-COURSE IMPROVEMENT POLICY

Dr M L Dhawale Homoeopathic Institute strives for the betterment of every student who is enrolled for Post graduate course. With this view the Institute proposes a policy of providing opportunities for every student which would help them improve on their academic and examination related performances.

The Institute proposed this policy in 2019. Under this policy each department can arrange for improvement strategies for its students.

The mid-course improvement strategies may be adopted, applying any or all of the below mentioned:

- Individual departmental formative assessment exams.
- Concept based exams and examining application (SCR tools exam on individual departmental level).
- Open book tests.
- Individual departmental assignments for every session.
- For part-1 integrated assignments before every session and timely inputs.
- Research subject assignments and mid-course exams.

The departmental faculty should notify the students beforehand regarding the tests, the venue and the timing. At the time of conduct of the exam minimum one departmental faculty needs to supervise he exam. The answer sheets of exams and assignments should be checked and marks should be allotted and feedback to be given to each student.

The answer sheets should be returned to the students for their future reference. A mark sheet should be prepared and circulated.
